BUILD a MODEL OF YOUR SYMBOL OR LANDMARK!

- **MATERIALS:** Use any materials you wish: Clay, dirt, sticks, wood, styrofoam, toothpicks, Legos, even materials from your recycling bin such as newspaper. Your creativity is more important in this project than creating a perfect replica. **Parents may advise and assist, but work should ALL be by YOU!!**
- **BASE:** Please build your model on a cardboard, plastic, wood, or other hard base for easy transport and display.
- **SIZE LIMIT:** Your model base must be **no larger** than 2 ft. x 2 ft. We just don't have enough room for anything bigger!
- **LABEL:** Legibly write the landmark or symbol and your name on the base.
- **WRITTEN REPORT:** You will do a written report about your symbol or landmark in class, but you are welcome to read and research at home.
